### **Abstract Specifications**

Abstract content must meet the following guidelines:

- The abstract should include a brief introduction of the topic, purpose, method employed, main findings or practical implications, conclusions, and recommendations
- The abstract should not exceed 300 words and should be original
- Five key words relating to the topic should be supplied along with the abstract

### **Abstract submission details**

Abstracts should:

- Be relevant and contain a complete title (up to 15 words);
- Contain the full name(s), affiliation(s), email(s) of the author(s);
- Be written in Times New Romans, 12, and 1.5-spaced; and
- Be accompanied with a one-paragraph biography of the author
